James Cook University, Brisbane campus, was recently selected to be involved with the Clinton Global Initiative for young entrepreneurs from Nepal by offering a scholarship to the entrepreneurs for training in their respective field of endeavour.

The Clinton Global Initiative, CGI, www.clintonglobalinitiative.org <<http://www.clintonglobalinitiative.org/>> encourages entrepreneurs to seek skills and knowledge and turn their intentions into real action and results. James Cook University Brisbane, JCUB's, role will be to deliver a 5-Day Global Business Executive Seminar. The aim of the Executive Seminar is to enlighten potential Nepalese business leaders on key business principles which they can apply to better their local communities.

The Executive Seminar consists of a blend of formal lectures, guest speaker presentations, interactive workshops and industry field trips aimed at broadening the outlook and expanding the potential of each participant. Case studies and examples will be drawn from various industry and government sectors relevant to Nepal and its emerging economy status. The industry field trips, scheduled for each afternoon during the program, will be under the guidance and supervision of a JCUB staff member.

On behalf of Sarina Russo, I am pleased to announce that you have been awarded a scholarship to allow you to travel to Brisbane for participation in the Executive Seminar series. Congratulations!

The scholarship holders should be approximately 35 years of age, possess an IELTS English language of 6.0 or equivalent, have an undergraduate degree or equivalent, not previously be a holder of a recognized scholarship and not pursuant of seeking Permanent Residency in Australia.

A function will be held in Kathmandu at a venue to be announced in the first week of August, 2009, during which time the scholarship winners will be announced with press and television crews in attendance.

The agenda of the Executive Seminar program is as follows:

- * Arrive in Brisbane on Friday 25 or Saturday 26 September;
- * Program duration is from Monday 28 September to Friday 2 October;
- * Visit Australia Zoo on Saturday 3 October;
- * Free day on Sunday 4 October;
- * Presentation of Final report on Monday 5 October; and
- * Depart Brisbane on Tuesday 6 October.

All costs associated with the scholarship program (return economy class travel from Kathmandu to Brisbane, and land costs in Brisbane) will be borne by CGI and the Sarina Russo Group, with the exception of costs related to obtaining the your passport and visa.

For the scholarship to be effected, James Cook University, Brisbane must be notified of the details of the scholarship recipient by cob Friday 17 July, 2009 by returning the Scholarship Acceptance Form.

- * Evidence of current employment and salary.
